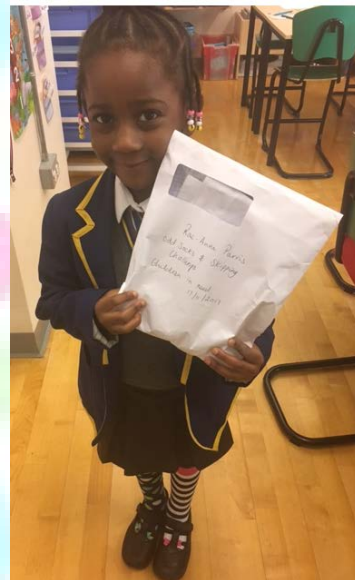

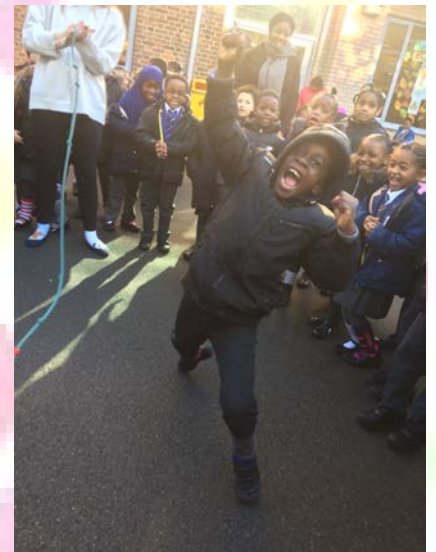


The children raised a HUGE amount of money for charity! Children in Early Years well and truly outdid themselves and should be very proud!
